

#10 STRIPES, LOOPS & PATCHES

MATERIALS

- Pure Merino by Berroco, 1.75oz/50g balls, each approx 92yd/85m (merino wool) in #8546 teaberry, #8567 chintz and #8552 wild berry
- Size 9 (5.5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

18 sts & 24 rows = 4" (10cm) using size 9 (5.5mm) needles over St st.
TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

SQUARE

With wild berry, cast on 36 sts.

Follow color chart through row 49. Bind off with chintz.

Loop 1

With chintz cast on 7 sts. Work in St st until 5"/12.5cm long. Bind off.

Loop 2

With chintz cast on 6 sts. Work in St st until 4"/10cm long. Bind off.

Loop 3

With teaberry cast on 6 sts. Work in St st until 5"/12.5cm long. Bind off.

Loop 4

With teaberry cast on 3 sts. Work in St st until 5"/12.5cm long. Bind off.

Loop 5

With teaberry cast on 9 sts. Work in St st until 4"/10cm long. Bind off.

Loop 6

With wild berry cast on 6 sts. Work in St st until 4"/10cm long. Bind off.

Loop 7

With wild berry cast on 10 sts. Work in St st for 4 rows.

Next row (RS) [K2tog, k1] three times—7 sts.

Work in St st for 5 more rows.

Next row K3, [k2tog] twice—5 sts.

Purl 1 row on WS.

Next row [K2tog] twice, k1—3 sts.

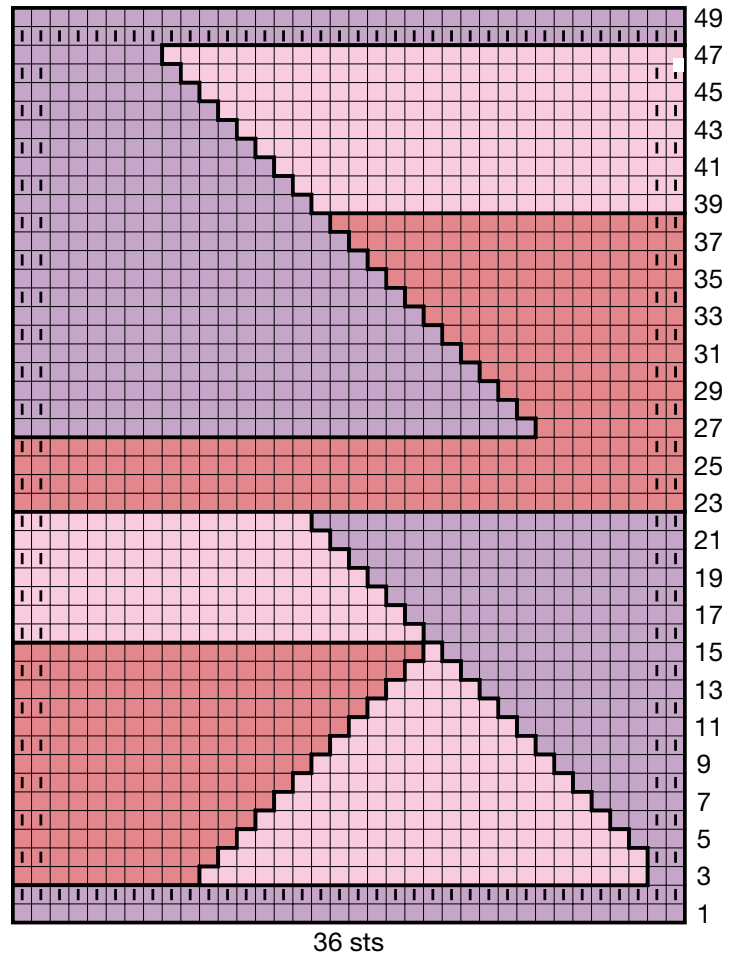
Knit 1 row on WS. Cont to work Rev St st over 3 sts until piece measures 4"/10cm long. Bind off.

Patches 1 and 2

With wild berry, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st for 14 rows. Bind off.

Follow diagram and sew loops and patches to purl side of square.
