

## #32 2-COLOR ANEMONE SQUARE

### MATERIALS

- *Pure Merino* by Berroco, 1.75oz/50g balls, each approx 92yd/85m (merino wool) in #8560 bordeaux and #8552 wild berry
- Size 9 (5.5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

### GAUGE

18 sts & 12 rows (two 6-row repeats) rows = 4" (10 cm) using size 9 (5.5mm) needles over anemone pattern.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

### STITCH PATTERN

#### Anemone stitch

(multiple of 4 sts plus 4)

**Rows 1–4** With bordeaux, knit.

**Row 5 (RS)** With wild berry k2, \*k1 wrapping yarn around needle twice; rep from \*, end k2.

**Row 6** With wild berry k2, \*sl 4 sts to RH needle dropping second wraps, sl sts back to LH needle, k same 4 sts tog without dropping from LH needle, p1, k1, p1 into same 4 sts, sl them off the needle, rep from \*, end k2.

Rep rows 1–6 for anemone pattern.

### NOTE

Carry yarn not in use along side of work.

### SQUARE

With bordeaux, cast on 36 sts.

Rep rows 1–6 of Anemone stitch 7 times, then work rows 1–4 once more.

Bind off with bordeaux.
